

Code of Conduct and Program Rules

We strive to provide a welcoming, safe, supportive and enjoyable environment for program participants. We believe that all individuals have the right to be treated with dignity and respect regardless of abilities or limitations. We are committed to promoting positive participation to ensure a successful and fun recreational experience for all.

Some rules and behavioral expectations for children are as follows:

- Respect staff, coaches and other children
- Respect property
- Follow directions
- Adhere to dress code (gyms shorts, shirts, socks, sneakers (basketball shoes if enrolled in basketball clinic or other appropriate training shoes if enrolled in speed/agility clinic)
- Stay within program boundaries
- Come prepared to work out and display a positive Attitude
- **If enrolled in the After School Basketball Clinic, athletes must be arrive a van pick up ON TIME**

Unacceptable behavior and actions are as follows:

- Unwillingness to share program equipment and supplies with others
- Not following the directions of staff/coaches
- Intentional verbal abuse including: teasing/taunting, harassment and/or profane language
- Hitting a person or fighting
- Intentional property damage
- Possession of instruments either constructed as a weapon or known as a weapon (knives, blunt objects, sticks, etc.)
- Inappropriate sexual touching
- Any action which exposes participants or staff to danger
- Consistent disregard of program policy and procedures (i.e. not following directions, consistently missing van pick-up or parents late pick-up from after school program etc.)

Discipline action that may be taken

- Reassign**, to another group
- Time-Out**, from an activity for short period of time, with staff supervision From the program for behavior resulting in extreme disruption, or intentional harm to self and others
- Removal**, for remainder of day, or next clinic date (if next clinic, date: _____)
- Suspension** from clinic for remainder of sessions in the event of extreme negative or destructive behavior
- No Re-Enrollment** for participants who have been suspended from a previous enrollment, if no re-enrollment.
